

Shawnee Twin Lakes

Swimming, Boating, Fishing, and Camping

Swimming

Shawnee Twin Lakes has two designated swimming areas located on Shawnee Lake #1.

- a. Isaac Waltons Park located at the dead end of Lake Rd.
- b. Glenn Collins Memorial Park located on the West side of Shawnee Lake #1.

Swimming is only allowed in Lake #1 and is free of charge.

Boating and Skiing

Boating is allowed on both Shawnee Twin Lakes 1 & 2 and requires a permit.

- a. Annual boating permit - \$26.00 (Must purchase at the Planning & Engineering office, 222 N. Broadway, Shawnee)
- b. Daily boating permit - \$7.00 (Purchase at the self pay boxes located at both boat ramps, cash only)

Personal watercrafts are allowed on Shawnee Lake #1 only. The same boating fees apply.

Skiing and tubing are allowed on Shawnee Lake #1 only.

Camping

There are 15 designated primitive campsites located at Isaac Walton Park at the dead end of Lake Rd.

- a. Camping fee - \$5.00 per site for two tents.
- b. No reservations
- c. Purchase camping permit at self pay box located in the Park.

Fishing

Fishing is allowed on both Shawnee Twin Lakes 1 & 2 and requires a permit.

- a. Annual fishing permit - \$15.00
- b. Daily fishing permit - \$3.00

Purchase permits at the self pay boxes located at both boat ramps and Isaac Waltons Park.
